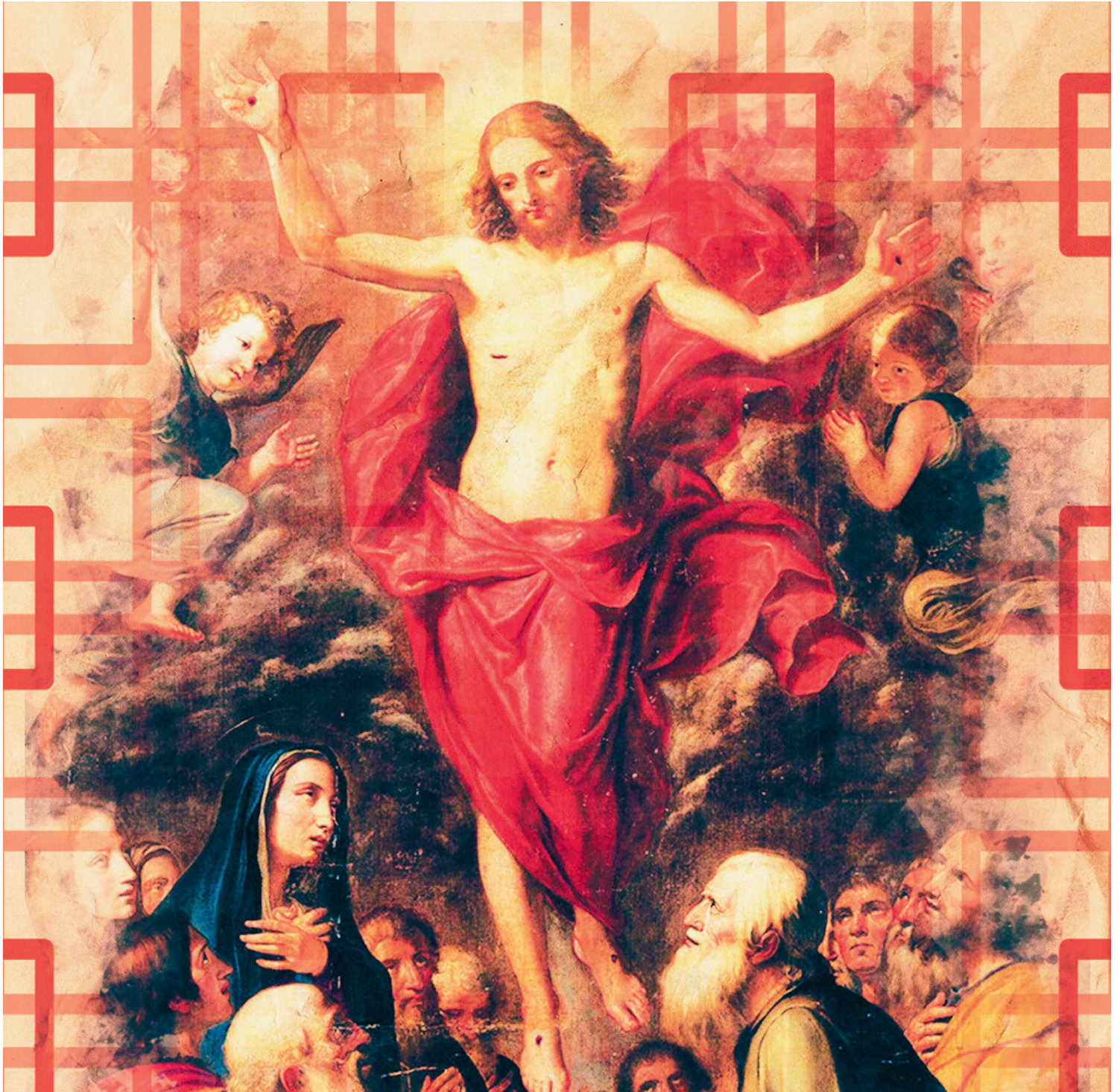

Please take time today to tell your mom how special she is and give her a hug. If she is already in heaven, ask her to pray for you.

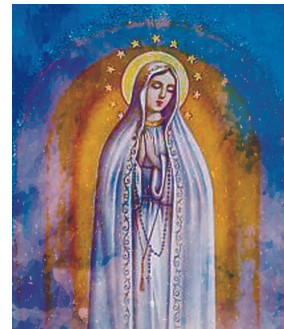

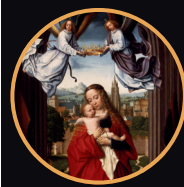
