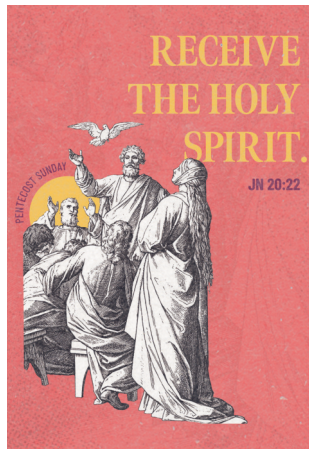

“There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone.”

Membership in a Parish is a Testament of our Faith

Perhaps one of the perennial questions is: *What really makes one a member of a parish?* Like every organization that we are a part of, there are certain expectations and obligations that reveal our true commitment to that organization. For a Catholic parish, I would reduce it to active participation and stewardship (parish support). This week I will explore the term “active participation.”

An active parishioner is one who faithfully and frequently participates in the sacraments, especially the Mass. He or she sees the Mass as an integral part of life, and as a means of sanctification. An active parishioner understands the treasures that are hidden in the Eucharist. The idea here is that being present and participating is what adds life to a parish. The church is not just the building; it is really people of God, in union with their pastor and the Universal Church, that forms the Church. The Holy Spirit resides not in an empty building, but in each of the members of the Church, especially during the Sacrifice of the Mass. Except for cases of death in a family, illness, old age, immobility, and other unforeseen circumstances, there is really no good reason for excusing oneself from Mass attendance.

Outside of the sacraments, there are other parish activities that require our presence. We show up to these events because we see ourselves as an integral part of the parish community. When we are active parishioners, we want to meet new and old parishioners, share stories, and build a stronger faith community. We seek the common good even when there are no personal gains. We look after the interests of all not just a few or a group of friends. An active parishioner strives to be a part of the solution. They are through their personal faith very flexible people who understand the exigencies of the time. Finally, the active parishioner is a person of deep faith. We will explore the other part of this article that deals with stewardship in the coming weeks.

Mass Stipends



The Diocese of Madison and our parishes are grateful to all those who have generously provided a donation for Masses, funerals, weddings, and quinceañeras in the past. The donation for these sacraments and services has remained the same for thirty years throughout the dioceses of Wisconsin.

Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time and to account for inflation.

The new suggested stipend structure is as follows:

- MASS STIPENDS | \$20**
- FUNERALS | \$75**
- MARRIAGES | \$100**
- QUINCEAÑERAS | \$100**

These new suggested amounts take effect with events that occur on or after July 1, 2024.

They do not apply retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount for an upcoming event (even one that falls after July 1, 2024).

The new fee structure will be applied to all new requests we receive for events that occur on or after July 1, 2024.

As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the sacrament or service with no fee.
